

Sam Bell is Wanderers' final new recruit of the summer transfer window, arriving on a season-long loan from Bristol City.

The 23-year-old winger is the son of former Wanderer left-back Mickey Bell, and joins the club with a wealth of experience at Championship level in the past two seasons, totalling eight goals and one assist in 87 games in the second tier.

Mike Dodds, Head Coach at the Wanderers, said: "Sam's got real talent down the left wing and gives us another option at the top end of the pitch.

"We're really pleased with the business that's been done throughout the window and look forward to welcoming the newest lads into the group and working hard as ever to turn our performances into results."

Director of Football Strategy and Data Intelligence Tom Stockwell said: "Sam is a direct winger who likes to get in behind the opposition and beat defenders 1v1.

"We are confident Sam will give us the injection of pace at the top end of the pitch we need to unlock defences and excite the fans."
