

Adams Park welcomed back a number of the stars of the run to the semi-final of the FA Cup 25 years ago when the Wanderers hosted Plymouth Argyle in the first round of this year's competition on Saturday.

Club captain at the time Keith Ryan was joined by Alan Beeton, Steve Brown, Dave Carroll, Mo Harkin, Martyn Lee, Jermaine McSporran and Ben Townsend in a packed-out Legends Lounge to reminisce about the stories of 2000/01, before receiving a special ovation on the pitch at half-time.
