

Ryan Tafazolli has called time on his Chairboys career, leaving the club this week to pursue a new opportunity in League Two with Swindon Town.

The defender, aged 33, arrived at Adams Park in 2020 and went on to play 128 times for the club, scoring 10 goals, including a notable match-winning brace against Crewe Alexandra and the opening goal in the League One play-off semi-final tie against MK Dons.

His last appearance came - coincidentally - against Swindon in the EFL Trophy last December before embarking on a loan spell in Hong Kong with Lee Man FC.
