We cannot accept the following:

Anything broken or with missing pieces.

Books with torn/missing pages.

Half used/scribbled/torn colouring books. Even if it is only one page, we can't accept it. Soft toys without CE labels.

Puzzles/games with missing pieces.

Opened/used toiletries/perfumes/aftershaves.

The sort of items that the charity love to receive in particular are:

- Gifts for teenagers, including make-up (boys and girls)
- Creative kits, like make your own jewellery or slime
- Art materials for older children, like watercolours
- Lego (even part sets) or construction kits
- Baby dolls

The gifts will then be distributed to families less fortunate throughout the HP5, HP6, HP7, HP8, HP16 and SL9 postcode areas in early December.
