

Wycombe Wanderers Women have reached the First Round Proper of the Adobe Women's FA Cup for just the second time in their history after securing a thrilling comeback victory over Chesham United on Adams Park on Sunday.

Cheered on by a crowd of over 250, the Chairgirls roared back from a two-goal half-time deficit, with Chloe Melton bagging a quickfire brace to level the scores before Jess Watkins gave Wycombe the lead, and Kayla Potter wrapped up the victory in stoppage time.

It continues the Chairgirls' flying start to the new campaign, sitting top of their league with a 100% win record and a goal difference of +22, and now defeating a Tier 4 local rival in the cup.
