

Wycombe Wanderers are delighted to announce the signing of midfielder Jamie Mullins from Brighton & Hove Albion.

The 20-year-old put pen to paper on his deal at Adams Park on Tuesday morning in time to feature in the friendly at Sutton United this evening, having played against the Chairboys for Brighton in a practice match on Saturday.

Mullins moved to Brighton from Bohemians in January 2023 and has featured regularly in the Seagulls' under-21 side, contributing eight goals and seven assists in 58 appearances, including a fixture at Adams Park in the EFL Trophy in January 2024.

The Irishman has been capped by his country at five different age groups and will wear squad number 21.

Head Coach Mike Dodds said: "Jamie's got a really bright future ahead of him in the game and we're excited to bring him to Wycombe to develop his career and add another option for us in midfield.

"He was playing senior football as a teenager over in Ireland and has kicked on again in Brighton's academy, so he's well placed to come here and challenge for first-team football."

Tom Stockwell, the club's Director of Football Strategy and Data Intelligence, added: "Jamie is a high potential player who can operate as a 6, 8 or 10 with his technical skills and tactical knowledge.

"Development of talented young players is a key part of our strategy moving forward, and Jamie definitely fits this profile, so we're looking forward to seeing him in a Wycombe shirt."
