

Spurs test up next for Chairboys

Wycombe's pre-season campaign continues with a behind-closed-doors friendly against Tottenham Hotspur on Saturday, kicking off at 11am.

The game will be played at the Premier League side's training ground at Hotspur Way, with no admittance for spectators, though updates will be issued across Wanderers' social media platforms.

Spurs also have a friendly at Luton Town later on the same day, but have confirmed that both fixtures will be contested by the first-team squad, with players divided into two groups to compete in the respective games.

It'll be Wycombe's fifth fixture of pre-season, having previously taken on Brighton, Sutton, Cheltenham and Barnet.

Wanderers' pre-season campaign continues with a behind-closed-doors fixture at Tottenham Hotspur's training ground on Saturday morning - the first of two friendlies the Premier League side will play that day.

New Spurs Head Coach Thomas Frank says he'll field a mixed squad for both the games against Wycombe and Luton later that day, while for the Blues, it's likely those who didn't feature at Barnet on Tuesday will be given the opportunity to benefit from 90 minutes of action or thereabouts.

Pre-season has yielded five goals from four games so far - three scored by Richard Kone - with Mike Dodds fielding varied XIs and experimenting with different systems ahead of the big League One kick-off at Bradford City on Saturday 2nd August.

The game is not open to the public but will be live-streamed on Tottenham's SPURSPLAY online channel, which requires a £45 annual subscription; it has not been possible to arrange a stream for WanderersTV.
