



Wycombe Wanderers are delighted to welcome Alex Morris to the club as a new First-Team Coach.

Alex spent nearly 30 years as a player and coach at Crewe Alexandra, developing his career on and off the pitch in their famed academy before stepping into a senior coaching role in 2017, going on to become assistant manager and manager.

He switched to Stoke City in June 2023 to become the Potters' Under-21 Head Coach, and moved into a first-team coaching role a year later.

The 42-year-old joined the Chairboys for training at Marlow Road on Thursday morning ahead of the League One meeting with Barnsley at Adams Park on Saturday.
