

Wycombe Wanderers Women 1-1 Bridgwater United W.F.C (6-7 on penalties)

Wycombe Wanderers Women bowed out of the Adobe Women's FA Cup First Round Proper after a dramatic penalty shootout resulted in sudden death, with visitors, Bridgwater, claiming the win.

Backed by a crowd of over 250 at The 1878 Stadium in Burnham, the Chairgirls held tier four opponents, Bridgwater, to a 1-1 draw in regular time after Laura Hennessy netted early for the Blues and Axelle Courlander stepped up between the sticks to deny the visitors of a winning goal.

The tie was forced to penalties, with nine spot kicks taken for either side in a sudden death shootout, but it was National League side, Bridgwater, who secured progression to the Second Round after putting away seven of their penalties compared to the Chairgirls' six.

Despite dropping out of the competition, it was still a performance and remarkable cup run to be proud of for the Chairgirls in what has been an outstanding start to the season.
