

Wycombe Wanderers Website Match Report

Armando Junior Quitirna scored twice as the Blues held Premier League side Tottenham Hotspur to a 2-2 draw in a pre-season friendly on Saturday morning.

Pape Matar Sarr scored first and last in the game for the hosts in the behind-closed-doors game at Hotspur Way, but Wanderers controlled proceedings for long spells and can be proud of their performance a week ahead of the start of the League One campaign at Bradford.

Sarr's opener came after Mikki van Sas parried Wilson Odobert's stinging drive and the Senegalese forward converted, but Quitirna levelled matters with a low drive which beat keeper Brandon Austin on the line.

Anders Hagelskjaer headed over the bar before the break, but Wanderers took the lead when Quitina finished Dan Udoh's pass with aplomb, and James Tilley nearly made it 3-1 before Sarr equalised from close range for Spurs.
