



Wanderers midfielder Caolan Boyd-Munce has been called into the Northern Ireland men's senior squad for their forthcoming World Cup qualifying fixtures against Luxembourg and Germany on 4th and 7th September respectively.

The 25-year-old has two caps for his country already, making his debut against Spain in June before featuring against Andorra three days later.

He'll miss the Blues' League One fixture against Mansfield Town on Saturday 6th September, which could be postponed if either side receives 3+ international call-ups that weekend.

Caolan will also be away with his country for Wycombe's Vertu Trophy tie against Colchester on Tuesday 2nd September.
