

## Barnsley Website Match Report

The Reds were dealt a cruel late blow at Adams Park as Wycombe Wanderers came from two goals down to clinch a 2-2 draw against the Reds.

It was a bright start from the Reds, and particularly Reyes Cleary. The young winger took his man on early doors and delivered into the Wycombe box, but it was well defended by the Chairboys.

In the thirteenth minute, the Reds almost went a goal to the good. Davis Keillor-Dunn pounced on a loose pass in the Wycombe backline and looked to slot past Will Norris, but the shot stopper was quick off his line to deny the forward with a smart save.

Just over ten minutes later, the Reds were ahead courtesy of Reyes Cleary. It was again sloppy play throughout the Wanderers' defence, which was capitalised on by Cleary, and he made no mistake in coolly picking his spot and finishing past Norris.

On the stroke of half-time the Reds looked to double their advantage. A sublime piece of trickery followed by a sixty-yard half volley pass from Keillor-Dunn found Cleary in space, before the winger looked to take on his man, but to no avail on this occasion.

The Reds began the second period exactly as they ended the first, and on the fifty-second minute the lead was doubled. Reyes Cleary showed brilliant determination to keep the ball in play before squaring to Jonathan Bland on the edge of the box, who let fly and saw his effort cannon back off the post. The ball then found its way to Keillor-Dunn, who got the ball out of his feet before rifling an effort into the roof of the net.

The Reds continued to battle well over the course of the second half and looked dangerous within the final third, but the all-elusive third goal evaded the away side.

In the eighty-eighth minute, the hosts pulled a goal back. Impressive play from Donnell McNeillly saw him get to the byline before putting the ball across the face of the Reds box, and it was turned home from close range courtesy of Sam Bell.

Just moments later, in the ninety-third minute, Wycombe were level. Alex Lowry picked up the ball on the edge of the Reds' box before trying his luck from range, and his effort nestled in the bottom right corner to earn the hosts a point.
