Match Report

Wycombe progressed to the third round of the Carabao Cup after defeating Bromley 5-4 on penalties following a 1-1 draw in normal time at the League Two club's Hayes Lane home.

Magnus Westergaard rounded off a brilliant team move by heading home the opener for the Blues, but Jude Arthurs smashed home an equaliser off the underside of the bar to level before the break.

Will Norris had done superbly to deny Marcus Dinanga, Ben Krauhaus and Nicke Kabamba, but the second half then belonged to the Chairboys who controlled possession and came closest when Alex Lowry's mazy run resulted in an effort which landed over the bar.

Wanderers finished the match with four teenagers on the pitch as academy stars Mekhi Savage, Arthur Gregory, Micah Olabiyi and Cam Stones entered the action, but after Bromley kept the visitors at bay, it came down to a penalty shootout.

Caolan Boyd-Munce, Alex Hartridge, Alex Lowry, Fin Back and Cam Stones were all successful from the spot and after Will Hondermarck hit the bar, Blues were able to celebrate their progress to round three.
