



Ewan Henderson is Wycombe Wanderers' eighth new signing of the summer, arriving from the Belgian Pro League having just spent a season with Beerschot.

The midfielder is a former Scotland youth international who developed through Celtic's academy before making 11 senior appearances for the club, as well as spending time out on loan.

He moved to Hibernian in January 2022 and spent 18 months with the Edinburgh side ahead of a year on loan with Oostende and a second year in Belgium with Beerschot.

Head Coach Mike Dodds said: "Ewan's a really energetic midfielder who's had a great start to his career in the top flights in Scotland and Belgium, and gives us another dimension in the middle of the park.

"He's played a lot of football in the past three years which stands him in good stead to come here and hopefully hit the ground running as he integrates into the squad in pre-season."

Director of Football Strategy Tom Stockwell commented: "Ewan is an exciting and well-rounded box-to-box midfielder who can score and assist as well as break up the play and build from deep. He is exactly the profile we wanted to add with his technical skills and tactical flexibility.

"At just 25, Ewan already has experience in the top divisions in Scotland and Belgium, and we feel again it's a strong statement of the direction we are going to be able to attract such a player to the club."

Ewan's move remains subject to EFL and FA approval and international clearance. He'll wear squad number 20 for the Chairboys.
