



## Wycombe Wanderers Website Match Report

**Blues earned a point from a hugely entertaining 2-2 draw with Peterborough United on Saturday afternoon.**

Brandon Hanlan opened the scoring for the visitors but quickfire goals from Joel Randall and Ephron Mason-Clark saw the home side lead at the interval.

Wycombe levelled through Luke Leahy's deflected free-kick and could've gone on to win it, with late chances just passing them by.

Matt Bloomfield named the same starting XI that blew away Fleetwood two weeks ago and nearly had the dream start when Dale Taylor headed on target on three minutes, only for keeper Nicholas Bilokapic to save.

Posh enjoyed a decent spell and saw Joel Randall's effort bounce through a crowd of players before Max Stryjek reacted quickly to turn it away, before Brandon Hanlan was denied one-on-one by the onrushing Bilokapic just outside the area.

Wycombe were full value for the lead given to them by Hanlan, who tucked home a clever assist from Joe Low after the defender twisted in the Posh box.

But the hosts turned the game on its head before the interval, with Randall equalising direct from a viciously swinging corner, before Ephron Mason-Clark finished a quick counter-attack with a smart finish in first-half stoppage time.

Dale Taylor almost levelled inside 18 seconds of the restart, but the keeper tipped his fierce drive over the bar after the striker took a clever touch to create the chance from Killian Phillips' pass.

Blues were well on top at the start of the half and saw Phillips' shot cleared off the line after another poor clearance by the keeper, before Hanlan was denied from a tight angle following Luke Leahy's free-kick.

The equaliser came courtesy of another sumptuous Luke Leahy free-kick, taking a nick off the head of Mason-Clark and flying into the net.

And from then on, Wanderers could've won it. Phillips saw a shot deflect just wide, Leahy's long-ranger was saved by the keeper and Sam Vokes almost had a birthday winner to celebrate, blocking Bilokapic's clearance but just not quite being able to turn it home.
