Wycombe chalked their second victory of pre-season on the board with a comfortable performance over Bournemouth U23s.

Brandon Hanlan opened the scoring early on, converting with a clinical finish into the far corner of the net.

Ali-Al Hamadi doubled the lead late into the second-half with a penalty, after Jack Young's over-the-top pass was handled in the box.

Strong outings from the likes of Jasper Pattenden, Connor Parsons and Jack Wakely summed up a solid night in Brockenhurst.

Hanlan got the Blues off to a flying start with an expert finish into the bottom right after Parsons; graft to win the ball allowed Young to tee up the former Bristol Rovers striker for his first of pre-season.

Parsons, who started down the left, got himself forward for a long ball to challenge a header at the near post, coming close in a showing effort.

Hanlan was in the mood to add another when Pattenden found him with a whipped cross on the right, but his header could only loop over the Bournemouth crossbar.

Parsons continued to show brilliant play as he took on his man and beat him into the box, but the shot that flew in from his pass was flagged for offside.

Pattenden and Hanlan linked up once again with an inviting ball into the box from the No.31 flashing just past our no.18.

Those same two combined once more and Hanlan got a strike off but it was a great save from the Bournemouth goalkeeper Billy Terrell to keep the score from doubling.

Trialist wearing no.23 made an impression in the first-half and carried it into the second with brilliant direct runs down the right-wing and fizzing crosses in search of goal number two.

After a period of little attacking chances, Young's long ball in search of Al-Hamadi struck the hand of a Cherries defender inside the box.

The Iraqi international stepped up for the spot-kick and found the bottom left past the 'keeper's outstretched glove.

Wanderers closed out the game without conceding to round off a strong performance all over the pitch, and face Southampton B on Saturday.
