

Wycombe Wanderers Website Match Report

Goals from Garath McCleary, Sam Vokes and Anis Mehmeti secured a hugely impressive victory for the Chairboys against Peterborough United at Adams Park on Saturday afternoon.

The home side trailed to Harrison Burrows' well-struck effort from 25 yards, but levelled shortly before the interval when McCleary nodded home from close range.

A cagey second half came to life when Nick Freeman produced a moment of magic to tee up Vokes for a tap-in to make it 2-1, before Alfie Mawson broke clear in stoppage time to square it for Mehmeti to put the icing on the cake.

Wycombe have now won back-to-back league games, following the triumph at Oxford seven days earlier.

Gareth Ainsworth called Freeman into the starting line-up with Dominic Gape missing through injury, while Brandon Hanlan and D'Mani Mellor were back on the bench after being sidelined since August.

Vokes saw an early header saved and Mehmeti's shot was blocked from 12 yards as the Blues started brightly, but the in-form Posh responded well and took control, with Burrows firing home from distance shortly after seeing a powerful effort denied by Max Stryjek.

Lewis Wing hit the wall with a free-kick before Stryjek made an important near-post save to keep it at 1-0, but the Posh were dealt a blow when the impressive Ricky Jade Jones was forced off with an injury.

McCleary had a shot blocked following a quickly taken free-kick from Wing, and Stryjek had to be alert to parry away a dangerous Jonson Clarke-Harris free-kick, but the equaliser came just before half-time when Wanderers strung together three headers in the box from a cross, the third being the clinical finish from McCleary.

After the break, Mehmeti had a golden chance to make it 2-1 when Vokes flicked a Stryjek clearance into his path, but fired over.

Frankie Kent headed over for the visitors before Wycombe took the lead when they worked the ball wide from an indirect free-kick and found Freeman, who twisted and turned away from his man before laying on an assist for Vokes to guide home.

McCleary hit the post with a cross that almost sailed straight in, before Stryjek made a vital save from Burrows as the clock struck 90.

Posh threw everything at a corner in stoppage time but when it was cleared, Alfie Mawson raced away down the left and teed up Mehmeti for a simple finish to wrap up the points in style.
